

# THRIVING IN THE DIGITAL AGE



## WHAT IS BLENDED LEARNING?

As part of Blended Learning, students will learn what is prescribed by the curriculum through a mix of home-based and in-school activities, and leverage both online and offline approaches to learning. This will provide students with more opportunities to learn at their own pace and to be empowered to take charge of their learning.

Let's first understand the three types of accounts you have in 2024



Password	All three accounts share the same password. Updating the password will update it for all applications.		

You must not lose your Student ICON email and password details! Save them securely on your phone

## MIMS is the same as Student ICON

When you see "Log in with MIMS", that is <u>exactly the same</u> as logging in with your Student ICON email and password.

# LOOKING AFTER YOUR PLD

#### Your PLD has 3 years of warranty & insurance

- The warranty ensures that any hardware errors are fixed by the manufacturer.
- Insurance is there to protect against accidental damage and theft.

#### Do your part and charge your PLD at home every night

• Can you imagine the school's electricity bill if 1200 students charge their PLD in school?



Do You Know?

- Insurance does NOT cover against accidental loss (eg left it at the bus stop).
- You need about 10% of battery for every hour of usage.

# FOR URGENT CASES!

We understand that sometimes your PLD just needs *a bit more power* to get through the day.

To help in these cases, the school will provide each class with <u>3 PLD chargers</u> to give your PLD a quick charge (at most 1 hour).





#### Bee responsible!

- Do not abuse this as we need to do our part to save electricity in school.
- Any chargers damaged through negligence will not be replaced.

# HOME-BASED LEARNING

Sec 1 -3s will have HBL in Term 1-4

Sec 4/5s will have HBL in Term 3 only

# WHY IS HOME-BASED LEARNING IMPORTANT?

A unique aspect of HBL days is that it is less structured than a normal day in a classroom, thus giving students the opportunity to learn how to balance curriculum expectations while pursuing their own interests that may extend beyond the curriculum.

# LEARNING TO BE A SELF-DIRECTED LEARNER

An important element of blended learning is that it nurtures the skills of self-directed learning.

With less of content teaching from teachers, students can learn to be independent, take control over their learning and develop self-regulation skills.

#### Who are Self-directed Learners?

They are individuals who:

- set themselves clear goals,
- act upon plans,
- take initiative,
- are open to learning and
- are motivated.



Home-Based Learning equips students with stronger abilities, dispositions and habits for independent and lifelong learning.
